CLASSIFICATION REGULATIONS FOR 2011

FEES AND CONDITIONS (all prices include GST):

Herd Visit fee payable on application	\$44.00
Adult Cows	\$11.00 per head
Animals resubmitted for higher award	\$11.00 per head
2 year old heifers (all heifers submitted)	\$11.00 per head
2 year old heifers (if only percentage)	\$11.00 per head

All animals submitted for classification must be registered.

Animals are to be in an enclosed area, concrete or mown grass
Classifiers may make random checks of tattoo brands of the animals.

You will be notified at least 7 days prior to the classifier visit.

Animals will not be penalised due to non-genetic defects.

Cows not calved may be assessed if considered close enough to calving to be properly evaluated.

All details of the animals must be available prior to classification.

AWARDS AND POINTS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>AWARD</u>	<u>POINTS & CONDITIONS</u>
Poor	Less than 65, no award.
Fair (F)	65-74
Good (G)	75-79
Good Plus (GP)	80-84
Very Good (VG)	85-89
Excellent (Ex)	90 points

AWARDS (continued):

Excellent

The cow must have two excellent scores in mammary. Three of five categories must be excellent.

The cow must have three normal calvings. A normal calving is one which followed a gestation period of approx. 300 days.

The cow must be in milk at the time of inspection and may be requested to be miked out.

Cows must have an average production index of 100+ to qualify.

FIRST LACTATION HEIFERS:

Maximum score VG 89.

All two year olds in milk must be assessed. This information is submitted for inclusion in ABV Type assessment.

Obvious two-year-old culls will be classified free of charge.

RESUBMITS:

Any animal may be resubmitted in an attempt to receive higher points and/or awards but not during the same lactation period as the current award was gained.

A resubmitted animal will hold her current record if the points are not raised.

Members are required to provide classifiers with points and awards currently held by each animal resubmitted.
